# «Meet the Programmers!» - Sunday 14/10, 18:00-20:00, Rialto Theatre on Stage

The ISFFC offers filmmakers and all interested individuals a rare opportunity to meet and interact with festival programmers and directors. This parallel event brings together film professionals from top international short film festivals, such as NDU IFF, Berlinale Shorts, Tampere FF, Winterthur ISFF, VIS Vienna Shorts. # Words on Film - Wednesday 17/10, 17:30-19:30, Old vinegar house, Limassol

This year's edition takes the audience on a literary journey traversing the art of cinema: the parallel programme "Words on Film" reveals the inherent connection between literature and the moving image.

Literature and Cinema are two forms of art, intrinsically connected since the early history of Cinema and up until contemporary times. The world film archive includes innumerable short and feature films based on or inspired by literary works. Hence, this year's edition explores and focuses on the multi-dimensional relation between Cinema and Literature, with the invaluable contribution of acclaimed Greek writer and director, Achilleas Kyriakides.
